#### SPECIFICATIONS

- Solid brass construction with uniform brass/matte black finish
- High-salt, moisture and UV resistance
- · High-temperature silicone o-ring for a water-tight seal
- High-temperature ceramic socket
- 8" stake included
- .5" National Pipe Thread for attachment to various ground stakes, mounts and risers
- 72" wire lead
- IP65 rated
- Works with MR16 bulbs


Note: Bulbs must be purchased separately. Works with MR16 bulb.

#### **SAFETY NOTES**

- Read and follow Instructions: Always follow the instructions provided in this manual
- · Make sure the power is turned off before installation or maintenance
- · For OUTDOOR use only with low-voltage landscape lighting systems
- Fixtures are only suitable for a 12-15 Volt AC power supply
- Not intended for use with pool or spa, do not submerge
- Use appropriate landscape wire and outdoor rated wire nuts

#### ASSEMBLY


#### Install the bulb

- Twist the top of the lens housing counterclockwise to unlock it, gently pull off
- Insert MR16 bulb and secure into place
- Reattach the lens housing and hand tighten with clockwise twist

#### Install the stake

- Feed the wire lead through the stake
- Thread the fixture onto the stake





#### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Layout fixtures at the locations where they will be installed.
- 2. Run landscape lighting wire from furthest point back to power supply to wire lights in a daisy chain manner. Ensure there is excess wire between each light to allow for future location adjustments.
- 3. Properly connect each wire to the landscape wire using outdoor rated wire nuts. The lead wire should connect to the landscape wire that came from the previous fixture and the wire that continues to the next fixture.
- 4. Install the fixtures pushing the stake into the ground. If the ground is hard, use a trowel to loosen the earth. Or, prior to wiring, pound the stake into the ground by placing a piece of wood on the stake and hammering the wood. Caution: Do not use a hammer or place pressure on the fixture itself as doing so may cause damage.
- 5. Turn on the power supply and ensure every fixture is working properly.
- 6. Dig a small 6" deep trench and bury the landscape wiring and connectors.
- 7. Aim the fixture by loosening the joint screw to adjust the tilt angle. Swivel the fixture by tightening or loosening the threading in the stake.

Note: Fixtures can be mounted to walls using a suitable surface mount (sold separately).

#### TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution Options
Fixture does not light up	<ol> <li>Power supply is not connected</li> <li>Bulb not installed correctly</li> <li>Wire connection is loose</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>Check that the power supply is plugged in or receiving power. Confirm that the landscape wire is properly connected to the power supply.</li> <li>Confirm that the bulb is securely installed</li> <li>Check the connection of the landscape wire and the lead wire.</li> </ol>
Light flickers	<ol> <li>Loose wire connection to landscape wire</li> <li>If light flickers on multiple fixtures, the wire connection to the power supply may be loose</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>Check the connections of the landscape wire and the lead wires.</li> <li>Disconnect the power supply, confirm that the landscape wire is properly connected to the power supply.</li> </ol>
Light is dim	<ol> <li>Maximum load of power supply has been exceeded</li> <li>Landscape wire run length has exceeded recommendation</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>Check the total wattage of the connected lights to confirm it meets recommendations. Or, increase the power supply wattage.</li> <li>Increase the gauge size of the landscape wire.</li> </ol>
